

Pacific Northwest Glass Guild Glass Gallery 2020 New Booth Layout

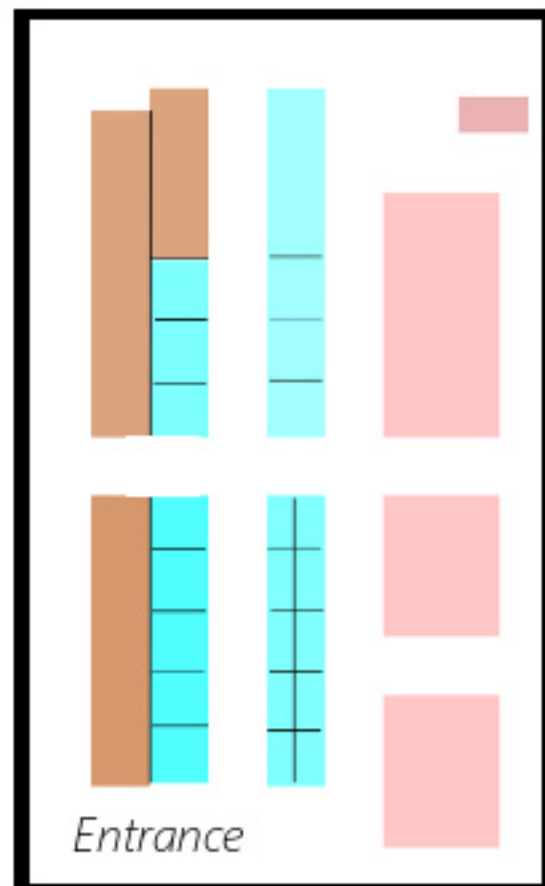
The booth layout has changed for the Glass Guild section. We have swapped places with the woodworkers, so in the map at the bottom brown represents wood and pink represents CMAG (metals). You can see that we have two aisles for customers, one is shared with CMAG, which gives us the opportunity to have 5'x10' booths facing the vendors across the aisle and 10'x10' booths that are open to both aisles.

This layout gives us flexibility and options for how many of which style of booth we need, so that is why on the application I am asking you to RANK your choice of booth style. Please help me out and give me at least 3 booth styles that will work for you.

Use the "notes" area after your signature to get more specific. DO NOT ASSUME that I remember any email or conversation we might have had! If you want to make sure I know, PUT IT ON THE APPLICATION FORM.

I am very excited about the opportunity we have here to provide the smaller booths, especially for new vendors, so please be flexible and understanding as we grow!

Black lines represent 3' draped walls. The shared wall with the woodworkers will probably be an 8' draped wall. 10x10 booths in the right hand aisle will be open to both aisles and displays must be visually appealing (vendors may not construct their own "back wall" that creates an unappealing experience for customers and other vendors).
